History of LLR

The South Carolina Legislature restructured a significant portion of state government in 1993. Effective Feb. 1, 1994, Act 181 created the South Carolina Department of Labor, Licensing and Regulation (LLR), merging the Department of Labor, State Fire Marshal's Office, the S.C. Fire Academy and 38 professional and occupational licensing boards to form the new agency.

The legislation empowered the governor to appoint a director of the department, with the advice and consent of the Senate.

LLR has been organized into four divisions: Administration, Fire and Life Safety, Labor, and Professional and Occupational Licensing.

The Office of the Director is made up of the director, the Office of Business and Governmental Affairs, and the Office of Communications and Ombudsman. The director is appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate.

This office is responsible for coordinating, monitoring and reviewing proposed legislation, amendments, regulations and approved bills that affect boards, commissions and divisions under LLR. This includes legislation initiated by LLR and all relative legislation drafted by parties external to the department.

This office promotes and explains the agency's goals, activities and services to the public. This division serves as the fire and life safety focal point for South Carolina, maintaining a statewide delivery system for fire prevention, protection and training services. The Division provides leadership, guidance and services needed by fire and emergency services personnel to carry out their responsibilities to serve at the local and state level. The division consists of the Office of State Fire Marshal and the S.C. Fire Academy.

In addition, under the State's Emergency Operations Plan, the Fire and Life Safety Division is the lead coordinator for Emergency Support Function (ESF) 9 – Search and Rescue and co-coordinator for ESF 4 – Structural Firefighting. The Division leads many established programs to accomplish this two-tiered mission of emergency response.

Office of State Fire Marshal (803) 896-9800

The Office of State Fire Marshal has regulatory responsibility to ensure compliance with state fire regulations. This is accomplished through inspection activities by deputy state fire marshals in the field and code consultation and plans review services provided by the engineering section. Fire prevention activities aimed at reducing the state's fire death rate are managed by the public fire safety education section. Activities include the distribution of smoke detectors, programs in the schools to educate youth, and the dissemination of timely fire safety information to the public.

In addition, the S.C. Urban Search and Rescue Team (US&R) provides initial and long-term responses to natural and manmade disasters. This nationally recognized program has developed into a best practice model with the US&R discipline. In 2009, the State US&R Task Force partnered with the S.C. National Guard to offer a statewide helicopter rescue program. This asset is one of only four in the country, and it provides South Carolina with the very best air rescue capability.

In addition, the South Carolina Urban Search and Rescue Task Force (SC-TF1) is a highly trained search and rescue asset. SC-TF1 is a part of the state's emergency operations plan and can be deployed in-state through the State Mutual Aid Agreement, or out-of-state through the Emergency Management Assistance Compact (EMAC).

The task force supports (but is not limited to) the following operations during deployment: structural collapse, disaster triage and assessment, large area search (urban, wilderness or water borne), canine teams, disaster medical team (medical center) and a myriad of rescue operational experience.

The State Fire Marshal's Office tests, certifies and/or licenses blasters and explosives companies, liquefied petroleum gas facilities and employees, outdoor fireworks displays and operators, proximate and indoor pyrotechnics displays and operators.

The office also oversees the Board of Pyrotechnic Safety, which assures compliance with state laws and regulations pertaining to the storage and sale of pyrotechnics (fireworks) within the state.

S.C. Fire Academy (803) 896-9800

The Fire Academy utilizes full and part-time instructors to provide on-site training and regional and local delivery through partnerships with local fire and emergency service agencies. The Fire Academy is a state-of-the-art facility that is one of the finest in the nation coupled with a mobile fleet for local program delivery.

The facility, along with its many regional offices, provides a statewide fire and emergency services training delivery system to serve the needs of the public and industrial sectors. The Fire Academy features modern classrooms, a dormitory, cafeteria and fire station. Burn buildings, flammable liquids, gas props and a five-story drill tower are used for live fire training. In

addition, an aircraft firefighting prop, made possible by a \$6.2 million grant from the Federal Aviation Administration, is available for the training of airport fire and rescue personnel.

The Division of Labor includes the South Carolina Occupational Safety and Health (OSHA) program and its offices: Statistics and Voluntary Programs; Office of Elevators and Amusement Rides; Office of Immigrant Worker Compliance; the Labor Management Mediation Office; and Payment of Wages and Child Labor.

In South Carolina, OSHA is a state-administered program. The purpose of the Occupational Safety and Health Act is to assure every working person a safe and healthy workplace. Safety and health compliance officers conduct inspections to ensure compliance with safety and health standards and may issue citations and assess penalties in cases of noncompliance. The Standards Section assists employers in interpreting OSHA standards and proper record keeping procedures.

The information gathered from the survey provides statistics on the number and frequency of nonfatal injuries and illnesses occurring in the workplace. It reports on the demographics and case characteristics for the more serious incidents. The CFOI program provides a comprehensive, accurate, descriptive, timely and accessible measure of all fatal work injuries occurring during a year.

Services are free to private and public sector employers upon request. No fines or citations are issued. Exemplary manufacturing industries are recognized as "Palmetto Stars" in the OVP Voluntary Protection Program (VPP) upon successfully meeting the program criteria. Also, small, high-hazard employers who meet the requirements are recognized as SHARP (Safety and Health Achievement Recognition Program) sites.

Amendments to the "South Carolina Illegal Immigration and Reform Act" were signed into law by Governor Nikki Haley on June 27, 2011. The amended law requires all employers to enroll in the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's E-Verify system by January 1, 2012, and to verify the legal status of all new employees through E-Verify within three business days. Failure to enroll in and use E-Verify to verify new hires will result in probation for the employer or suspension/revocation of the employer's business licenses.

By state law, the LLR director is responsible for assisting in the settlement of labor disputes. Mediators monitor contract negotiations, investigate industrial disputes, strikes and lockouts, and try to help the two sides reach agreement. When requested by both parties, mediators offer grievance mediation. The office also administers the S.C. Right-To-Work law, which provides that the rights of workers will not be abridged based on their affiliation or non-affiliation with a labor union.
