CALL TO ORDER

Dr. Garcia called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m. and noted a quorum was present to conduct business. Dr. Garcia informed Board members of the roll call and asked each member to state their names.

APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA

Dr. Garcia called for a motion to approve the agenda.

Motion: Dr. Carew made a motion to approve the agenda. The motion was seconded and approved.

APPLICATION HEARING:

Ronald J. Shows, DC: Dr. Shows consent agreement was submitted to the Board. Dr. Shows did not make a personal appearance. Erin Baldwin, Office of General Counsel, presented to the Board an original Consent Agreement that Dr. Shows signed for revocation of his license.

Dr. Garcia asked for motion regarding the signed Consent Agreement.

MOTION: In open session, Dr. Roles made a motion to accept the Consent Agreement. The motion was seconded and approved.

Governor Haley's Executive Order, Directive to Review Current and Proposed Regulations, Statutes, and Policies

Dr. Garcia informed board the step to discuss the next topic on the Agenda. Dr. Garcia also wanted the minutes to reflect Mr. Mercer had joined the meeting.

Sara McCartha, Board Advising Attorney explained the purpose of the meeting. The Governor issued an Executive Order which creating a Regulatory Review Task Force and tasked all cabinet agencies, which includes LLR to review all statutes, regulations, rules and policies to identify burdens on South Carolina businesses. In discharging those duties, each agency should consider factors to include, but not limited, to their necessity, complexity, efficiency, effectiveness, redundancy, public complaints and comments, shorts and long-term effects, impact on all affected persons both intended and unintended, and unintended negative consequences.

Several suggestions were made to include some of the following:

Changes to the exam when renewing a license.

Dr. Mruz suggested newsletters on the Board's Website which is a valuable tool.

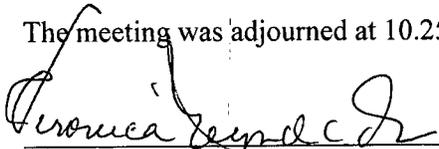
Dr. Roles suggested linking documents on the Website to the newsletter and it on a biannual or twice a year basis.

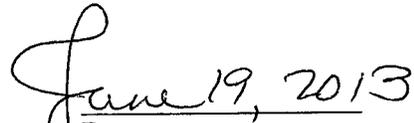
Ms. Reynolds suggested newsletters online be sent as an E-blast to all licensees
