Office of Investigations and Enforcement (OIE) Report: Ms. Reynolds presented the statistical report to the Board.

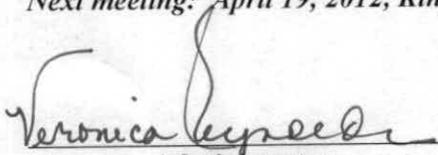
Office of General Counsel (OGC) Report: OGC did not have anything to report.
