State Certified Technician Education and Practical Experience Policy and Procedure #135

Per 40-43-82(B)(1)(a) a pharmacy technician applying to become a state certified technician must have worked for one thousand hours under the supervision of a licensed pharmacist as a technician and must have completed a Board-approved technician training course as provided for in 40-43-82(D). For purposes of this statute, a course that is either ASHP-accredited or PTCB-recognized is considered a Board approved course. All other courses must apply directly to the Board for evaluation.

Pharmacy technicians submitting hours of practical experience for state certification must obtain those hours in a permitted facility under the supervision of a licensed pharmacist or in those sites that comply with the description listed in 40-43-85(G).
