LLR ACCEPTING 2018 SAFETY AWARD APPLICATIONS

Columbia, South Carolina – The South Carolina Department of Labor, Licensing and Regulation would like to invite employers to participate in the 2019 Safety Awards program. The program recognizes companies’ efforts to reduce recordable occupational injuries and illnesses during the past year.

The program is open to any qualifying South Carolina employer, whether large, small or public. Awards are presented in three categories:

Rising Star	A difference of at least 75 percent in an employer’s 2018 incidence rate and the 2017 <i>national</i> average rate for that industry	A difference of at least 50 percent in an employer’s 2018 incidence rate and the 2017 <i>national</i> average rate for the applicable State or Local government NAICS
Gleaming Star	Less than 100 employees and demonstrates a culture of safety and health both on site and in the community	Less than 100 employees and demonstrates a culture of safety and health both on site and in the community
