## MINUTES

Monday, February 11, 2019

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Delisa Clark, Council Chairman, announced that notice of this meeting was properly posted at the Building Codes Council Office, Synergy Business Park, Kingstree Building, and provided to all requesting persons, organizations, and news media in compliance with §30-4-80 of the South Carolina Freedom of Information Act.

### 1. **Welcome and Call to Order:**

### 2. **Approval of Agenda:**

#### **MOTION:**

Ms. Hopkins made a motion to approve the agenda for the February 11, 2019, meeting. Mr. Cullum seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

### 3. **Code Modification:**

- a. International Mechanical Code-Section 504.8.2-Dryer Vent Deformation.
- b. International Residential Code-Section 1502.4.2-Dryer Vent Deformation

Mr. Lowe explained to the Council that the request from the Home Builders Association to delete the last sentence (“where dryer exhaust ducts are enclosed in wall or ceiling cavities, such cavities shall allow installation without deformation”) was presented to the Committee members earlier and they voted to keep the language exactly as it is.

#### **MOTION:**

Mr. Cullum made a motion to revise the language to read, “Where dryer exhaust ducts are enclosed in wall or ceiling cavities, such cavities shall allow the installation without deformation. The ductwork may be ovalized as long as it terminates in an approved duct box.” Ms. Hopkins seconded the motion which carried unanimously.
