ANNUAL CPE AUDIT: 2025 CALENDAR YEAR

The annual CPE Audit for the 2025 calendar year is underway. If you have been selected for audit, you are required to submit your CPE records, including all supporting documentation, such as certificates of completion through your account in the NASBA CPE Audit Service. The South Carolina Board of Accountancy retains final authority on the acceptance of individual courses and supporting documentation for CPE credit.

CPE RULES RELATED TIPS

- The annual 2-hour ethics requirement must be met each year and cannot be met using carryover hours.
- CPE hours must be completed within the applicable calendar year from January 1 to December 31.
- There is a 12-hour daily limit on CPE per regulation 1-08(A)(2)(e).
- When taking a self-study CPE course that is more than 12 hours, you will need to provide documentation from the CPE sponsor showing the date the course was purchased or started to claim any credit in excess of the 12-hour daily limit.
- If the purchase date/start date is the same as the completion date or the licensee doesn't provide documentation from the sponsor to demonstrate that they completed the course over multiple days, they would be limited to the 12-hour daily limit.
- All self-study courses must be QAS approved. Your certificate of completion should contain information on whether the course was QAS approved. You can also verify if a CPE sponsor is an approved sponsor for the QAS Self Study Delivery Method on the NASBA registry using this link: <https://cpeauditservice.nasba.org/confirm-registry-sponsor>.
