ACCOUNTING PRACTITIONER REQUIREMENTS AND INSTRUCTIONS

1. No prior history of dishonest or felonious acts:
2. Be a resident of this State or have a place of business in this State, or as an employee, be regularly employed in this State;
3. Be at least eighteen years of age; and
4. Meet these requirements:
 - (A) Pass the Financial Accounting and Reporting (FAR) and Regulation (REG) sections of the CPA examination; **and**
 - (B) Have a Bachelor's degree with a major in Accounting from an institution that is regionally accredited; **and**
 - (C) Have a passing score of 90 or better on the Professional Ethics: The AICPA's Comprehensive Course. Go to www.cpa2biz.com or 1-888-777-7077 to order.
5. Complete and pass the Financial Accounting and Reporting (FAR) and Regulations (REG) sections of the CPA EXAM. You can either go to NASBA's website www.nasba.org and apply or call 1-800-CPA-EXAM (272-3926).

Submit the following with your application to the above address:

- Check or Money Order in the amount of **\$150 (\$50 Application Fee, \$80 one year Licensing Fee, \$20 Certificate Fee)** made payable to **LLR- Board of Accountancy** (Fees are non-refundable)
A returned check fee of \$30, or an amount specified by law, may be assessed on all returned funds.
- Copy of your valid Driver's License, State Issued ID or Passport
- Copy of your social security card
- 2x2 Passport Type Photo taken less than 6 months prior to the application
- Legal documentation of name change , if applicable
- Certificate from Professional Ethic Course: The AICPA's Comprehensive Course
- Notarized Verification of Lawful Presence

Have submitted directly to the Board office address above from the issuing agent:

- Official transcript(s) from **all** institutions attended

NOTE: Your application is good for three (3) years from the date of receipt. If all required information is not received within this period; you must begin the application process from the beginning. This includes, but is not limited to, all fees, transcripts, license verifications, etc.

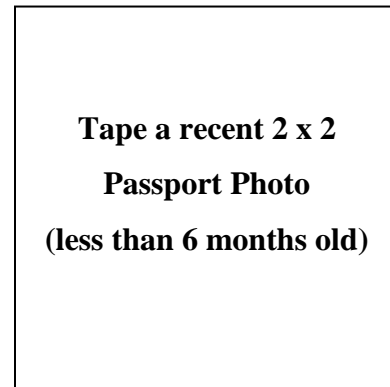

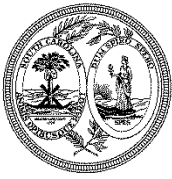
