The Estate of William Wetmore, Jr.
Hearing on a Claim against the Recovery Fund pursuant to Section 40-6-350

MOTION: Mr. Holiday made a motion to award recovery fund claim to claimant. The motion was seconded by Mr. Hope. Board members discussed the statutory parameters involving claims against the recovery fund.

<u>MOTION:</u> Mr. Hope made a motion to go into executive session for the purposes of seeking legal advice. Ms. Duncan was included in executive session. The motion was seconded by Mr. Holiday, which carried unanimously.

MOTION: Mr. Holiday made a motion to exit executive session, where no votes were taken. The motion was seconded by Mr. Hope, which carried unanimously.

MOTION: Mr. Hope made a motion to find the Claimant has met their burden of proving licensee is in violation of the Auctioneer Practice Act; that the claim against the recovery fund is based on multiple auctions; and that the claimant be awarded \$13,280 pursuant to Section 40-6-360. The motion was seconded by Mr. Holiday, which passed unanimously.

The Board reminded Complainant that in the even the Claimant is able to recover monetary damages from the licensee, the Auctioneer Recovery Fund must be reimbursed. Claimant acknowledged that he understood.

The Claimant thanked the Commission members for their time.

The Commission concluded the hearing and returned to the agenda.
