Renewal Instructions / Requirements:

- Renewal form, fee (\$300 made payable to Auctioneer’s Commission) and any other applicable documentation are due by June 30, 2019. All fees are non-refundable. A returned check fee of up to \$30, or an amount specified by law, may be assessed on all returned funds.
 - Renewals postmarked July 1, 2019 – July 31, 2019 will have a late fee of \$25 assessed. (\$325)
 - Renewals postmarked August 1, 2019 – September 30, 2019 will have a late fee of \$100 assessed. (\$400)
 - Licenses not renewed by September 30, 2019 will become lapsed. After September 30th, a new application will need to be submitted and an exam taken for reinstatement.

- If you have had a legal name change since your initial licensure or since your last renewal, please attach the legal documentation with this renewal form (Marriage Certificate, divorce decree, court documentation).
