IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ALL SOUTH CAROLINA AUCTIONEERS

Renewal applications for all Auctioneer licenses – individual, firm, and apprentice – are due by June 30, 2025. Licensees, who do not renew prior to that date will be lapsed. Licensees have until September 30, 2025, to renew with late fees. Any licensee in lapsed status after September 30th must reapply for licensure and meet requirements for a new licensee.

You can renew your license <u>online</u> or you can locate the paper application on the Commission <u>website</u>. The online renewal system will open on April 1, 2025 and will be available through June 30, 2025.

All Auctioneer licenses (not firms) are required to complete 8 hours of approved continuing education (CE) during the two-year renewal period (7/1/2023-6/30/2025). **All required CE must be completed prior to renewing a license.** The Commission requires you to report your continuing education through your free basic account with CE Broker. If you have not already created your free account with CE Broker, please do so <u>here</u>. Some education providers will report your CE for you, but you must check with the provider to see if this is completed.

Commission staff will complete a CE audit after September 30, 2025, to assure all licensees have taken the required CE. If you do not have your continuing education up-to-date in CE Broker, you will receive a notice from staff. Failure to complete all required CE prior to renewing may result in a fine. If you cannot supply information showing completion of required CE, your license may be administratively suspended.
