**1. Meeting Called to Order**

**2. Discussion Regarding the Barber Practice Act**

Ms. League presented a draft of the statute to the Task Force for review. The Task Force then reviewed the draft and provided their own suggestions, comments, and questions.

Topics included the definition of a mobile barber shop and whether that includes kiosks; the requirements of a mobile shop; defining/refining certain items in the regulations; whether to remove the barber assistant license; how many permits/years a student has to complete their hours; whether language regarding a 90-day work permit should be added; who can work in a mobile barber shop; removing the requirement to be a resident of South Carolina as it is unconstitutional; and whether to remove the work affidavit requirement.

During the meeting, Mr. Robinson had to leave early and Ms. Patton led the rest of the meeting.

Ms. League will take everyone's comments and suggestions into account to create a new draft to be reviewed at the next Task Force meeting.
