Ms. Theresa Brown stated based on the information that was previously worked on, a secondary curriculum was prepared and is in the materials.

Mr. Robinson stated that a meeting was held last Monday, April 3, 2023, with himself, Ms. Brown, and Ms. Mary League. Mr. Robinson stated during the meeting, they reviewed and created a Registered Barber and Master Hair Care Specialist Curriculum as a starting point.
