

NOTICE TO BUILDING DEPARTMENTS

Re: Extension of Temporary Licenses for Residential Swimming Pool Contractors

On January 25, 2024, the Contractor's Licensing Board authorized an extension of all Temporary General Contractor Licenses with the Swimming Pools Classification to June 30, 2024. All Temporary General Contractor Licenses with the Swimming Pools Classification will now automatically expire on June 30, 2024. No extensions will be authorized beyond this date. Licensees will be re-issued paper licenses reflecting the new expiration date.

Prior to expiration, any temporary licensee wishing to continue performing work in the General Contractor Swimming Pools Classification must submit the appropriate application to the Board, showing passage of both the swimming pools technical exam and the S.C. Business Management and Law for Commercial Contractors exam. Requests must be in writing and received by the Board not less than five (5) days prior to expiration of the temporary license. Temporary licensees who fail to request active licensure prior to expiration of the temporary license will be required to submit an application and meet all qualifications for initial licensure prior to resuming work in the General Contractor Swimming Pools Classification.
