The committee recommends approval the advisory opinion that physician assistants prescribing C2 medication, that the Board of Medical Examiners does not interpret the language of the PA Act as amended to impose an obligation upon the pharmacy in question to verify compliance with 40-47-965. Licensees under the Board of Medical Examiners, supervising physicians and p physician assistants are expected to comply with the Medical Practice Act and are subject to discipline if they do not. Pharmacies may choose to implement their own verification procedures for prescriptions in accordance with the requirements of the Pharmacy Practice Act. Coming from a committee, a second motion is not needed. It carried unanimously.

The committee recommends for the Board to follow the Practice Act in regards to verbal orders. Coming from a committee, a second motion is not needed. It carried unanimously.
