

Internet Pharmacies Policy and Procedure #125

The South Carolina Board of Pharmacy, at its September 29-30, 1999 meeting, stated: The South Carolina Board of Pharmacy highly objects to internet, on-line, sites that have combination dispensing and prescribing services, based on public safety concerns. If the public so chooses to utilize Internet sites, the Board of Pharmacy recommends using the Verified Internet Pharmacy Practice Sites (VIPPS), a service site provided by the National Association of Boards of Pharmacy licensure.
