Renewal Instructions/Requirements:

- Renewal fee in the form of a check or money order (no cash) made payable to LLR-Perpetual Care Cemetery Board. (All fees are non-refundable. A returned check fee of up to \$30, or an amount specified by law, may be assessed on all returned funds.)
- Renewal postmarked on or before December 31, 2025:
 - Perpetual Care Cemetery (10 acres or less) fee is \$400.
 - Perpetual Care Cemetery (more than 10 acres) fee is \$850.
- Failure to renew by December 31, 2025, renders the license invalid.
- A license may be reinstated if postmarked on or before January 31, 2026.
 - Perpetual Care Cemetery (10 acres or less) fee is \$400.
 - Perpetual Care Cemetery (more than 10 acres) fee is \$850.
