WELCOME AND CALL TO ORDER:

Mr. Lehman, Committee Chairman, called the scheduled meeting of the Alarm System Regulatory Review Committee Meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN'S REMARKS – Daniel Lehman

Mr. Lehman, Chairman, did not make any remarks.

ADMINISTRATOR'S REMARKS – Molly Price

Mrs. Price stated that the committee was appointed by the Board on October 21, 2021, with the purpose of working with industry representatives from the South Carolina Electronic Security & Technology Association to review the South Carolina Alarm System Business Act, Chapter 79, for potential updates and changes. She stated that there had not been significant updates made to the Practice Act in roughly 22 years.

REVIEW OF ALARM SYSTEM BUSINESS ACT

The committee reviewed Chapter 79, South Carolina Alarm System Business Act, and identified potential administrative updates and items that they felt would require additional research and discussion. Most notably, it was discussed that several definitions in Section 40-79-20 needed changes to reflect the current practice of alarm system contracting. It was also noted that the application requirements for businesses, qualifying parties, and registered employees needed an administrative clean up to clarify what was needed for initial and renewal applications.
