

NASCLA Accredited Examination Program

The National Association of State Contractors Licensing Agencies (NASCLA) Accredited Examination Program was designed to assist contractors and tradesmen who wish to become licensed in multiple jurisdictions by offering a streamlined test taking option for the trade portion of the examination. Candidates who take and pass a NASCLA Accredited Examination can access NASCLA's National Examination Database (NED) located on https://ned.nascla.org to electronically send their transcripts to jurisdictions that accept the examination in lieu of their state specific trade portion as an examination waiver. This helps in promoting contractor mobility and portability when crossing state borders to become licensed, reducing the need to take similar trade examinations in each state. Classifications included are for Commercial General Building Contractors, Electrical Contractors (Master/Unlimited Electricians), Journeyman Electricians, and Residential Electrical Contractors.
