

**MINUTES**  
**South Carolina Board of Cosmetology**  
**10:00 A.M., November 28, 2005**  
**Conference Call**

Rosanne Kinley, Chairman, of Anderson, called the conference call meeting of the SC Board of Cosmetology to order at 10:00 am. Other board members present included: Melanie Thompson, Vice Chairman, of Myrtle Beach; Michelle Hampton-Furtick, of Columbia; Delores Gilmer, of Charleston; Ruth Settles, of Greenville; and Katherine Webb, of Easley.

Staff members participating in the meeting included: Connie Huffstetler, LLR.

Members of the public attending the meeting included: Cody Lidge, University of South Carolina.

**Meeting Called to Order** - Public notice of this meeting was properly posted at the S. C. Board of Cosmetology office, Synergy Business Park, Kingstree Building and provided to all requesting persons, organizations, and news media in compliance with Section 30-4-80 of the South Carolina Freedom of Information Act.

**New Business**

Approval of 2006 Continuing Education Classes

*Palmetto Professionals of Cosmetology*

The members discussed the updated packet submitted by Mr. Lacy and agreed that all the information was now correct.

**MOTION**

Ms. Settles moved to approve the 2006 Continuing Education packet submitted by Palmetto Professionals of Cosmetology. Ms. Gilmer seconded the motion.

Ms. Kinley asked if there was any further discussion. Ms. Thompson noted that they had not yet addressed the matter of the continuing education classes held in May 2005, during which some irregularities occurred, that the Board had agreed to address at this time. Ms. Hampton-Furtick recused herself from the discussion.

Ms. Settles stated that she felt that since this was a new association, no action should be taken. Ms. Thompson said that as an instructor, Mr. Lacy was well aware of the requirements and should not be excused.

**AMENDED MOTION**

Ms. Thompson moved to amend the motion to include a letter of reprimand to Palmetto Professionals of Cosmetology with a probationary period of one year for the violations which occurred at the May 2005 continuing education class. Ms. Webb seconded the motion to amend the original motion. The amendment carried with Ms. Settles abstaining and Ms. Hampton-Furtick recusing herself from the vote.

**CALL FOR THE VOTE**

Ms. Kinley called for the vote on the motion to approve the 2006 Continuing Education classes for Palmetto Professionals of Cosmetology with a letter of reprimand and a probation of one year. The motion carried with Ms. Hampton-Furtick recusing herself.

### Proposed Cosmetology Regulations

She noted that under Section 35-24, Continuing Education Programs, she would like to add that Board Members receive credit for continuing education classes that they monitor and for which they submit an evaluation.

The members discussed various aspects of the idea and agreed to send their suggestions to Ms. Kinley by Monday, December 5.
