2. Discussion of Draft Regulation for Issuance of Temporary Work Permits

The committee met to discuss a possible regulation regarding emergency temporary work permits. Ms. League provided some thoughts regarding temporary permits for individuals who are unable to examine when, due to a public emergency, the licensing exam is not available. Both Ms. Delaney and Ms. Clark-Horton stated that they felt a draft regulation on this topic was important, and agreed with moving forward to develop draft language to take to the Board.

The committee members reviewed and discussed language for a draft regulation, including whether the candidate should have taken one part of the exam prior to qualifying for a temporary permit; when the temporary permit would be available to be issued; and whether a permit could be issued if a part of the exam had been failed. After discussion, Ms. Delaney and Ms. Clark-Horton approved draft language for the committee to present to the Board for review.
