

Surveyor-in-Training (LSIT) Qualifications

Pursuant to SC Code of Laws, Section 40-22-225(B), the minimum qualifications for certification as a surveyor-in-training, are:

Graduation from a school or college of four or more years with a board-approved degree or an ABET commission accredited curriculum in a related field, including not less than twelve (12) semester hours or the equivalent in quarter hours of discipline-specific courses satisfactory to the board in each of the disciplines described in Section 40-22-20(26) for which the applicant is requesting licensure and has passed the NCEES Fundamentals of Surveying examination as prescribed by the board.

Per Section 40-22-20(26) the practice of Tier A surveying consists of three separate disciplines: land surveying, photogrammetry and geographic information systems.
