Program Coordinator Remarks – Johnnie Rose

Mr. Rose welcomed everyone to the Committee meeting and thanked Board members for volunteering their service and time. Mr. Rose stated the reason we are having this meeting is because we need some clarification and a guide to follow while processing out of state applications. There's been a couple of cases to where we have been challenged by individuals to grant a license that is not equivalent to the grade they carry in their previous state(s).

Committee's Recommendation

Delegate to staff the authority to grant a license based on the information received in the questionnaire from the respective state. If the applicant is coming from a state or territory that administers the ABC Exam, and has met all other licensing requirements, they should be eligible for the grade of license equivalent from the state in which they are coming from; however, if staff is unable to make a decision in regards to the application and questionnaire, the Board will make a ruling to determine if the applicant's credentials are comparable for reciprocity in South Carolina.
