Review of Draft of Proposed Regulation Changes to Present at July 23 Board meeting.

Mr. Stuart and Mr. Hendricks proposed the following changes to the Chapter 53 draft of proposed regulation changes:

- Section 53-2: Change to state that the Board will elect officers each year. Delete numbering
 under "Vice-Chairman" duties and change it to read that the Vice Chairman will perform the
 duties of the Chairman in his/her absence.
- Section 53-3: Clarify verbiage to state that the Board will meet twice each year.
- Section 53-11: Add verbiage requiring reciprocity applicants to pass the Section Two South Carolina Specific Examination.
- Section 53-20: Change item "D" to read "individuals who are at least 60 years old —"

Committee's Recommendation

Mrs. Moorer will implement the changes and email the updated draft to the committee members for final review to present at the July 23, 2020, Board meeting. Staff will also work on developing an application for continuing education waivers.
