Renewal Instructions/Requirements:

- Renewal fee in the form of a check or money order (no cash) made payable to LLR-Board of Funeral Service. (All fees are non-refundable. A returned check fee of up to \$30, or an amount specified by law, may be assessed on all returned funds.)
- Renewal / Late Fees:

Funeral Director or Embalmer

Postmarked 10/31/20 or before: \$300

Postmarked 11/1/20 or after: Late fee 120 + Renewal Fee 300 = 420

Dual Funeral Director and Embalmer

Postmarked 10/31/20 or before: \$320

Postmarked 11/1/20 or after: Late fee 120 + Renewal Fee 20 = 440

After November 1, 2020, the license must be reinstated. Continued practice may result in disciplinary action.

Continuing Education (CE) Broker registration is now mandatory for Funeral Directors and Embalmers. You
