## 2022-2024 FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND EMBALMER RENEWAL APPLICATION

### **Renewal Instructions/Requirements:**

- Renewal fee in the form of a check or money order (no cash) made payable to LLR-Board of Funeral Service. (All fees are non-refundable. A returned check fee of up to \$30, or an amount specified by law, may be assessed on all returned funds.)
- Renewal / Late Fees:

# Funeral Director or Embalmer

Renewed/postmarked on or before 7/31/2022: \$300

Renewed/postmarked on or after 8/1/2022: Late fee 120 + Renewal Fee

### **Dual Funeral Director and Embalmer**

Renewed/postmarked on or before 7/31/2022: \$320

Renewed/postmarked on or after 8/1/2022: Late fee \$120 + Renewal Fee \$320 = \$440

After August 1, 2022, the license is expired and must be reinstated. Continued practice may result in disciplinary action.

• Continuing Education (CE) Broker registration is now mandatory for Funeral Directors and Embalmers. You must set-up a CE Broker account and upload all required CEs before you can renew your license.
