• Check or money order only made payable to Long Term Health Care Administrators Board (Fees are non-refundable). A returned check fee of up to \$30, or an amount specified by law, may be assessed on all returned funds. NO CASH IS ACCEPTED.

- Documentation of required Continuing Education.
 - o Per Board Regulations 93-150(D), licensees wishing to reactivate from retired status must:
 - Proof of six (6) hours of continuing education during the previous twelve (12) months.
 - Proof of an additional fourteen (14) hours of continuing education within 90 days of the license being activated or the license will automatically be replaced in the retired status and the licensee must immediately cease and desist any work in a nursing home or community residential care facility in the State.

Please note:

• If the license has been retired for five (5) years or more, the board may require passing of the examination(s) in lieu of or in addition to the CE requirement.
