## COVID-19 Extended Time for Licensing Examination Requirement

### Provisional License

In response to the temporary closing of PSI testing centers, the Board is allowing all Provisional Licensees extended time to take the NAB examination. The new deadline is June 30, 2020. PSI anticipates opening testing centers on May 1, 2020, so Provisional Licensees are encouraged to contact PSI for the next available NAB examination date.

The Board will continue to monitor the status of the PSI testing centers and will provide further updates as necessary.

### AIT Programs

Due to facility lockdowns, many AIT programs have been placed on hold until such a time as the facilities are allowed to reopen to the public. AIT candidates are responsible for notifying the Board office at [contact.lthca@llr.sc.gov](mailto:contact.lthca@llr.sc.gov) of their program interruption. The AIT candidate's remaining program time will recommence beginning the first of the month after the internship is resumed.

All AIT registrations expiring April 1, 2020 to June 30, 2020, have been extended to September 30, 2020, in keeping with the SC Department of Labor, Licensing and Regulation's renewal extension.
