- All license renewal applications must be accompanied by:
 - A current criminal background check from the state of residence for the person completing the Renewal Application. For South Carolina criminal background reports contact SLED at www.sled.sc.gov or (803) 737-9000. Out-of-state applicants may submit a state-issued report or any report generated by an accredited agency on PBSA’s website found here: thepbsa.org/. **All criminal background reports must not be older than thirty (30) days from the date of application.**
 - A Bond Continuation Certificate or proof of surety bond coverage in the amount specified in S.C. Code of Laws Section 40-29-230, if not currently on file with the Board. The Bond must be payable to the Board and coverage must be for the duration for the 2022-2024 licensure cycle.
 - Legal documentation of name change (marriage certificate, divorce decree, etc.), if applicable
- Check or Money Order, only, in the amount specified below made payable to SC Manufactured Housing Board. Application fee is non-refundable. **NO CASH IS ACCEPTED.** A returned check fee of up to \$30, or an amount specified by law, may be assessed on all returned funds.
- Incomplete applications will be returned.
