NOTICE TO BUILDING DEPARTMENTS

Per S.C. Code Ann. Section 40-29-200, "All licenses expire June thirtieth of each evennumbered year following the date of issue, unless earlier revoked or suspended." "Continuation in business without proper license will be deemed a violation of the Act," per S.C. Code Ann. Regs. 79-6(B). Licensees that have not submitted a complete renewal application on or before June thirtieth of each even-numbered year have expired licenses. Licensees may renew with a late fee through December 31, 2024, after which time they will be required to qualify as new applicants, including passing the appropriate examination(s).

79–6. License Renewal.

- (A) Penalty for failure on the part of the applicant to file a renewal application shall be as follows:
- (1) A late fee will be assessed for applications received after the end of the renewal period.
- (2) If a licensee fails to renew within six months the applicant/authorized official is required to qualify as a new applicant.
- (B) Continuation in business without proper license will be deemed a violation of the Act.
- (C) All license renewals must be accompanied by a current criminal background check, and verification that the applicant has obtained the required continuing education with the exception of manufacturers.
