Respiratory Care Practitioner [RCP] Renewal and Continuing Education Information

1. Continuing Education Timeframe - You must have completed at least thirty (**30**) hours of continuing education in the RENEWAL PERIOD [June 1, 2023 to May 31, 2025).

RCPs in their FIRST renewal cycle after receiving their initial permanent license are NOT required to complete CME <u>for this renewal period only</u>.
