Renewal Tips

ACCESS THE LLR ONLINE SERVICES PORTAL <u>NOW</u>. Know your userid and password, safeguard it and
use it to renew online as early as possible in your renewal period after you have completed any required
CME. Watch for emails from the board with important renewal information. Look for renewal information
under *Board News* at <u>www.llronline.com/pol/medical</u>

- a. If you do not know your USERID and Password, go to https://eservice.llr.sc.gov/OnlineRenewals/ and click on "I Forgot/Do Not know my User ID and/or I Forgot My Password."
- b. A valid email address on file with the board is required.
- c. If you do not have a current email address on file with the Board, please email the Board at Medboard@llr.sc.gov with your name, license number, last 5 digits of your social security number and current email address.
- d. Don't forget about the ability to designate a proxy payor for renewal. This information will come up as an option under Online Services during your renewal.
- 2. Renew EARLY and renew ONLINE during the 90-day period your license is open for renewal and <u>after</u> you complete required CME.

Continuing Medical Education

You are NOT required to send actual CME certificates, transcripts etc. to the board office to renew (Keep them for your records in case of a board CME audit)

- *Licensees in their first renewal cycle, the first renewal, after receiving their permanent license are not required to complete CME.
- *CME must be completed during the 24-month period preceding the renewal deadline date for your license and before you renew online!
- *Partial CME Credit for Volunteer Service: SC Code 38-79-30 Any licensed health care provider who renders medical services voluntarily and without compensation or the expectation or promise of compensation and seeks no reimbursement from charitable and governmental sources may fulfill one hour of continuing education for each hour of volunteer medical services rendered, up to a maximum of twenty-five percent of the provider's required continuing education credits for the licensure period. **SC Code SECTION 38-79-30(B)**

*Don't forget about the ability to designate a proxy payor for renewal. This information will come up as an option under Online Services during your renewal.

Military Provisions for Renewal

SECTION 40-1-610. Continuing education exemption.

A person whose profession or occupation is regulated by this title is exempt from completing continuing education requirements for his profession or occupation while serving on <u>active military duty.</u>

SECTION 40-1-620. License fee exemption.

A person whose profession or occupation is regulated by this title may not be assessed, and is exempt from being required to pay, a license fee for his profession or occupation for a calendar year in which he serves any period of active military duty.

PHYSICIAN CME FOR RENEWAL IS...

- 1. 40 hours total
- 2. AMA/AOA Category 1
- 3. Taken during the renewal period –July 1, 2017 to June 30, 2019
- 4. Subject matter-30 hours in specialty, 10 hours may be non-specialty.
- 5. Two of the total 40 <u>must</u> be in appropriate procedures for prescribing and monitoring controlled substances.
- 6. These two hours are required every two years <u>regardless of</u> <u>specialty or whether you actually prescribe controlled substances!!!</u>

Physicians may also claim up to ten (10) hours for volunteer medical service.

1. 24 hours total for ALL podiatrists. *Podiatrists with an active DHEC/DEA controlled substance prescriptive authority registration must also complete two (2) hours of continuing education related to appropriate procedures for prescribing and monitoring controlled substances. These two (2) hours are included in the twenty-four (24) hour total.
