

Online Voting for Medical Board Run-off Election – to all active, permanent Physician MD/DO credentials

Subject: Medical Board At-Large Seat Run-off Election

Pursuant to South Carolina Code Section 40-47-10 and Reg. 81-91, the South Carolina Board of Medical Examiners will conduct a run-off election for the At-Large Board Seat.

The online voting portal will open May 2, 2022, and will remain open until midnight on May 17, 2022. No ballots may be accepted after midnight on this date. The names of the run-off candidates will be included on the election ballot, and you will be allowed to cast one vote.
