NBCRNA Reentry Program for CRNAs

The Reentry Program is offered to individuals who have had a lapse in their certification and/or their license or authority to practice nurse anesthesia for four or more years and who wish to reestablish their eligibility for certification and reenter the nurse anesthesia practice. The Reentry Program provides the opportunity for a nurse anesthetist to obtain current knowledge and the skills necessary for safe nurse anesthesia practice and enables the nurse anesthetist to become CPC compliant and restore his/her eligibility for certification.
