



Remediation Guidelines

Remediation:

Applicants for licensure by examination who have not achieved licensure within one (1) year of graduation (or first taking of the examination, if foreign educated) are required to complete a remedial program satisfactory to the Board prior to retesting. The remedial program must consist of a general comprehensive review of nursing.

Remediation providers may include:

- a. Individualized programs provided by a Board approved tutor
- b. Board approved nationally recognized or private vendor review courses
- c. Board approved additional study provided by a nursing education program

Responsibilities of Applicants:

1. **Prior to beginning remediation**, notify the Board of Nursing in writing of the name of the provider selected.
2. Provide the Board of Nursing with the title, objectives and date(s) of the remediation program before starting the program.
3. Arrange for the educational provider to submit notarized documentation of remediation program completion directly to the Board of Nursing.

The notarized verification of remediation completion must be on file at the Board of Nursing before the applicant will be determined eligible to retake the examination.

Requirements for Individualized Tutorial:

1. The individual tutor must have the following qualifications as verified by curriculum vitae:
 - a. Hold a minimum of a BS degree in nursing
 - b. Two of the past five years of experience as a nurse educator, nurse administrator or a clinical nurse specialist
 - c. Holds an active unencumbered nursing license in the State of South Carolina
2. The tutor must provide the Board of Nursing with the following:
 - a. A written assessment of the candidate's learning needs and clinical skills
 - b. Objectives reflecting candidate learning needs
 - c. Outline of the tutorial program
 - d. Evaluation methodologies
 - e. Verification of completion of remediation
