Electronic Licensure

The South Carolina Board of Examiners in Optometry is now issuing electronic licenses.

As of today, individuals who are approved for initial licensure, or permit, and individuals who renew their license or permit, will receive an email from our office with instructions on how to log in to your account and print a copy of your new or updated license or permit. This document will be available to print within forty-eight (48) hours after the approval or renewal. The Board will no longer mail paper licenses.

A printed license must be displayed in a prominent and conspicuous place in each location in which you practice. A printed mobile unit permit must be affixed in a prominent and conspicuous place within the mobile unit.

To print your license or permit you must log into the [eService Portal](#) using the User ID and Password you created when applying for or renewing your license. Board staff cannot provide this information.

If you need assistance accessing your account, click “Forgot Username” to retrieve your User ID or “Forgot Password” to reset your password.

After logging in, select “Print License Card.” You may print as many copies as needed. This option allows you to reprint your license at any time, eliminating the need to request a replacement from the Board.
