Supervisory Agreement

The SC Physical Therapy Practice Act allows practice under a provisional license to:

- 1) An applicant who has met all requirements for licensure except completing the clinical practice hours pursuant to Section 40-45-220 (A)(2)(d) and Section 40-45-20 (2)(a)(b)(c).
- 2) A person whose license has been inactive or lapsed for three or more years and who has applied to reinstate the license.
- 3) An applicant whose practice needs to be restricted as determined by the Board.

On-Site supervision is required for 1, 2, and 3.

Supervisor: I agree to provide supervision of the provisional licensee identified below in accordance with Section 40-45-260 (B) of the state law. I will provide onsite supervision as defined with section 40-45-20 (2)(a)(b)(c). Employment will not begin until I have received of the provisional license from the Board.
