2019 Legislative Update Board of Physical Therapy Examiners

The following bill was enacted by the General Assembly during the 2019 legislative session and may impact the Board of Physical Therapy Examiners and/or the Board of Physical Therapy Examiner licensees:

Physical Therapy Exam, H.3703/Act 64

The Act allows an applicant for licensure to take the physical therapy exam up to six times. If the applicant fails the exam the fifth time, he or she must take courses required by the board and furnish evidence of completing those courses before taking the exam the sixth time.
