# Approval of the Meeting Minutes from September 17, 2014

# **MOTION:**

Mr. O'Kelley made a motion to amend his previous motion on lines 170 – 199 from the minutes of the September 17, 2014 meeting, to read as follows:

"Motion to accept the Memorandum of Agreement signed by Ms. Douglas. Her Broker in Charge license will be revoked and downgraded to salesman status, which is suspended for a period of two (2) years. That suspension is stayed and her salesman license will be on probation for a period of two (2) years. Further, she will be required to pay a \$500 fine for each violation, for a total of \$2000 within two (2) years. Ms. Douglas may not apply for a Broker in Charge license in the future without appearing before the Commission. She will be required to take Ethics and Trust Accounts classes for a total of eight (8) hours within the next six (6) months. Ms. Douglas must submit quarterly progress reports to the Commission with updates on her progress in paying restitution referenced in her testimony today. If any conditions are not met, her salesman license will be automatically revoked."
