# Penny Boling

The Commission held a Disciplinary Hearing regarding Penny Boling. Ms. Boling was present and was represented by David Haller, legal counsel. Rowland Alston, Office of Disciplinary Counsel, represented the State, and presented the facts of the case. Mr. Alston informed the Commission that Ms. Boling has signed a Memorandum of Agreement. The Commission reviewed such agreement and discussion ensued.

Mr. Crigler made a motion to enter Executive Session to receive legal advice. Mr. Poplin seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

Mr. Rinehart made a motion to enter Open Session. Mr. Poplin seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

# **MOTION:**

Mr. Stackhouse made a motion that the State has met its burden of proof that Mr. Moore has violated S.C. Code Ann. 40-57-135 (A) (1) (1976, as amended); S.C. Code Ann. 40-57-135 (C) (2) (1976, as amended); and S.C. Code Ann. 40-1-110 (1) (f) (1976, as amended). Respondent will be given a Public Reprimand and his license will be revoked. A penalty of eighteen hundred twenty-five dollars will be assessed. Mr. Moore will be issued a Cease & Desist Letter and will be required to appear before the Commission prior to being approved for a license in the future. Mr. Crigler seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.
