 - Residential Home Builders** must have a current surety bond on file in the amount of \$15,000. The surety bond must be an original (no copies or facsimiles) in the builder’s name only and signed by the builder. **If your surety bond has expired, please submit with this renewal application a current continuation certificate or a new surety bond.**
 - Residential Home Inspectors** – If you obtained your Residential Home Inspectors License with a Residential Home Builders License, you must renew your Residential Home Builders License first.
 - Return the completed renewal application, Surety Bond (if applicable) and payment made payable to: **LLR-SC Residential Builders Commission, PO Box 11329, Columbia, SC 29211-1329.** Your application must be postmarked by the Post Office on or before June 30, 2020, to avoid additional late fees.
 - It is the individual’s responsibility to notify this office, in writing of any name and/or address changes. Name changes require a copy of legal documentation(i.e., marriage license, divorce decree court order)
 - A returned check fee of up to \$30, or an amount specified by law, may be assessed on all returned funds. All fees are non-refundable.
