Renewal Instructions/Requirements:

- Renewal fee in the form of a check or money order (no cash) made payable to SC Residential Builders Commission. (All fees are non-refundable. A returned check fee of up to \$30, or an amount specified by law, may be assessed on all returned funds.)
- Biennial Renewal / Late Fees:

Renewed/postmarked on or before 6/30/2022: \$220

Renewed/postmarked 7/1/2022 - 6/30/2023: Late Fee \$50 + Renewal Fee \$220 = **\$270**

Reinstated after June 30, 2023: Reinstatement Fee \$260 + Renewal Fee \$220 = \$480

- After June 30, 2023, your license must be reinstated.
- Residential Home Builders must have a current surety bond on file in the amount of \$15,000. The surety bond must be an original (no copies or facsimiles) in the builder's name only and signed by the builder. If your surety bond has expired, please submit with this renewal application a current continuation certificate or a new surety bond.
- If you have had a legal name change since your initial licensure or since your last renewal, please attach the legal documentation with this renewal form (Marriage Certificate, divorce decree, court documentation).
