

EXAMINATION WAIVER AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the North Carolina Licensing Board for General Contractors (the Board) and the South Carolina Residential Home Builders Commission (the Commission) have determined that it is in the best interest of the public to provide for reciprocity of licensing for the practice of general contracting between the states of North Carolina and South Carolina upon the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth.

1. The Board agrees to waive the requirement that an applicant successfully complete the Board's licensure examination, if the applicant is currently licensed by the Commission and has successfully completed the Commission's licensure examination.

2. The Commission agrees to waive the requirement that an applicant successfully complete the Commission's licensure examination, if the applicant is currently licensed by the Board and has successfully completed the Board's licensure examination.

3. Licenses issued pursuant to this Agreement shall be issued only for equivalent and/or compatible classifications.

4. This Agreement applies only to the examination requirement, and all other licensure requirements of the Board and the Commission must be met before a license may be issued pursuant to this Agreement.

5. This Agreement shall become effective on ^{NOVEMBER 22,} October 1, 1990 and may be terminated by the Board or the Commission at any time thereafter.
