

Notice to Licensees Regarding Continuing Education for the Renewal Cycle Ending January 31, 2021

At its meeting on September 15, 2020, the Soil Classifiers Advisory Council determined that as a result of the public health state of emergency declared by Governor McMaster earlier this year, the limit of ten (10) hours for self-directed study hours for continuing education in Regulation 108-5.A.3 is suspended to allow licensees to obtain all continuing education hours through self-directed study for the 2019-2021 renewal cycle only. This means that ALL continuing education activities may be obtained through online courses or other self-directed activities for this reporting period. This is a one-time exemption. The Council will resume the requirement for structured education activities for the reporting period of February 1, 2021 – January 31, 2023.

License renewals will open on November 1, 2020. Notifications will be sent by email to individuals who validate their email address, or by U.S. mail to individuals who do not validate an email address.
